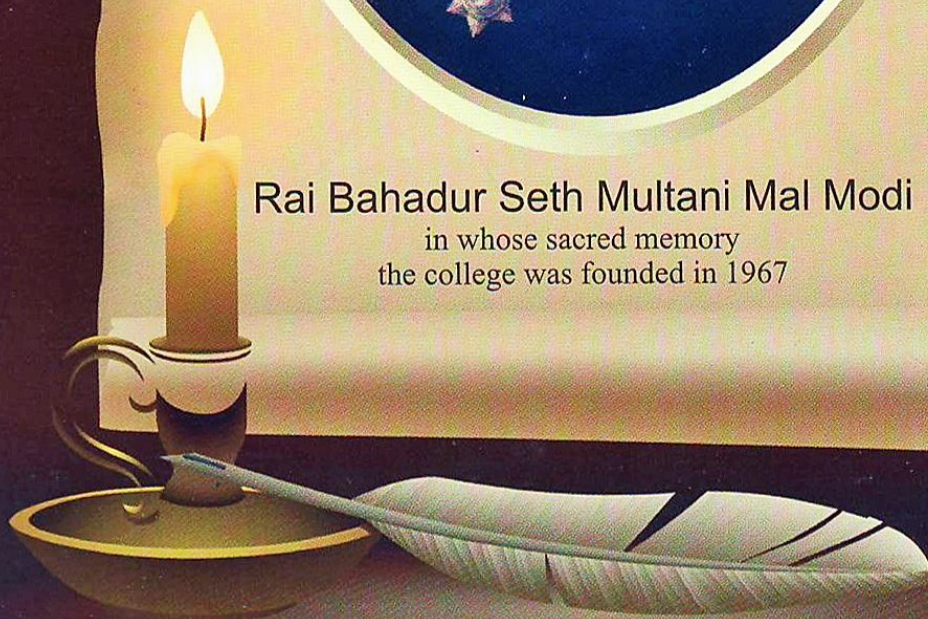

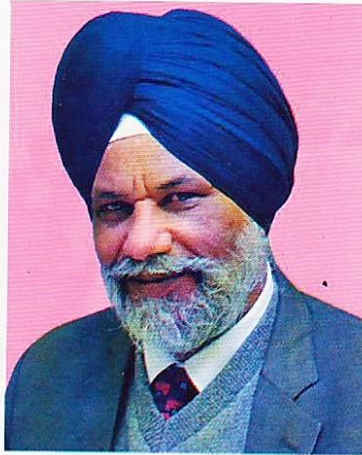

## Infrastructure

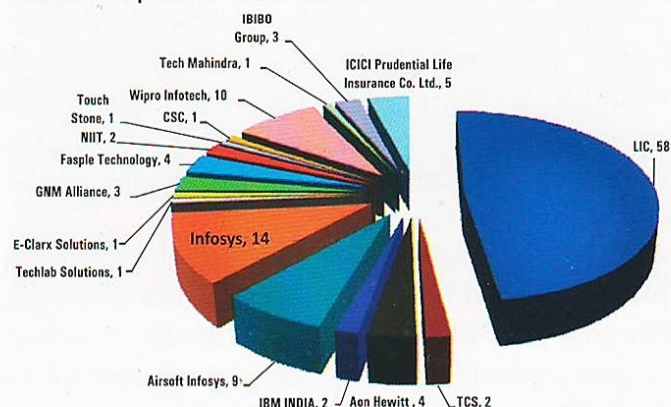




## Healthy Practices

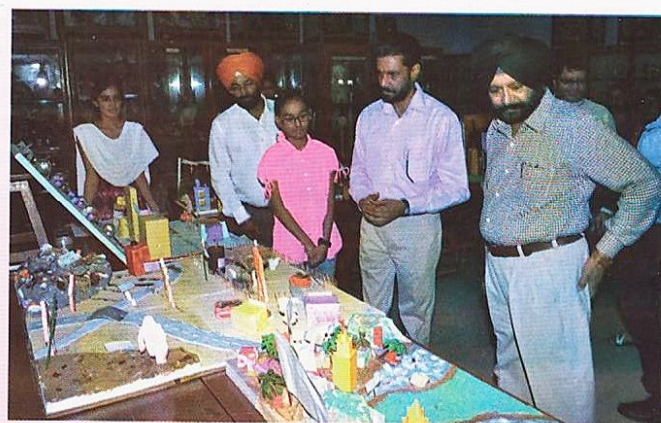

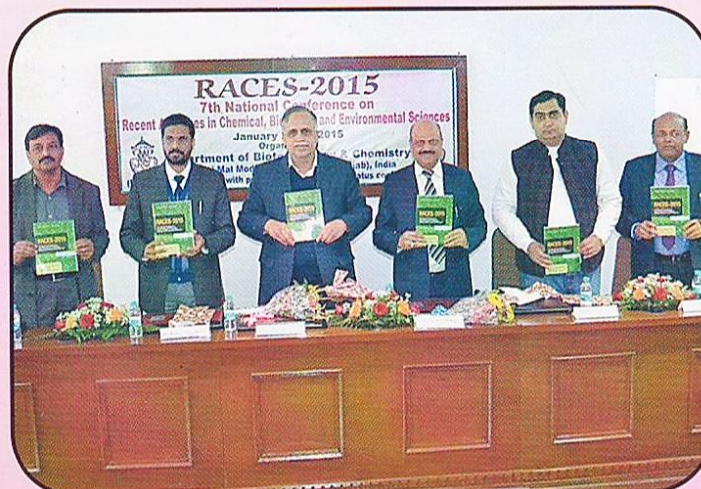
