Achievements in Academics (2015-16)

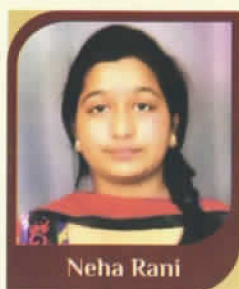

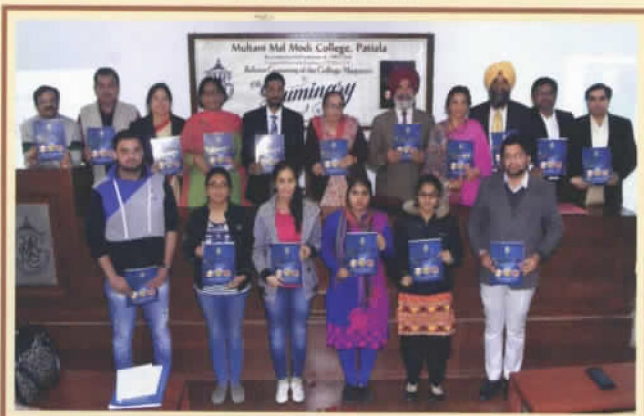
