





Professor Arvind Vice-Chancellor, Punjabi University, Patiala

Professor Arvind is a well-known Theoretical Quantum Physicist with a keen interest in Science Education, Communication and Pedagogy in Punjabi. Professor Arvind is currently the Vice Chancellor of Punjabi University Patiala and is on deputation from IISER (Indian Institute of Science Education & Research) Mohali where he is a Professor of Physics. He did his M.Sc in Physics from IIT Kanpur and obtained his PhD in Theoretical Physics from the Department of Physics and Centre for Theoretical Studies, at the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 1997. He then joined the Physics Department of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar as a faculty member. From 2002 to 2004, he was a special faculty at the Physics Department of Carnegie Mellon University, Pittsburgh, USA. He joined the Physics Department of Indian Institute of Technology Madras as a faculty member in 2005. In August 2007 he moved to IISER Mohali as one of the founding faculty members and helped in setting up the institute. He has held several administrative positions at IISER Mohali, including Dean (Research), Dean (Students), Head Computer Centre, Coordinator Outreach, and Officiating Director. Professor Arvind has received the INSA medal for Young Scientists 2000. Professor Arvind is the National Coordinator of Theme-1 (Photonics) of the National Multi-Institutional Networked Programme on Quantum Enabled Science and Technology (QuST) which was launched by the Department of Science and Technology, New Delhi in 2018 with a total budget of around Rs 300 crores. He is also a member of the DPR drafting committee for the National Mission on Quantum Technologies and Applications (NMQTA).

He has over 70 publications in international journals and has supervised 7 PhD students and over 40 MS Theses. His current research interests encompass Quantum Information Theory and foundations of Quantum Mechanics. Professor Arvind is keenly involved in contributing to education, especially in the context of teaching of science in schools as well as universities. Through various platforms such as television panel discussions, newspaper articles, social media and seminars, Professor Arvind has been drawing attention towards the major problems in the education system of India. He was an expert on the panel discussion at the Indo-German Symposium on Science Communication titled 'Bringing Science to the People' in 2017 at NIPER Mohali. He has also been vocal about improvements in student-teacher ratio, pedagogical innovations, institutional policy in science education, better evaluation strategies, problems in recognizing merit and tapping talent, dwindling status of teachers in the community and broadening the notion of literacy and science education. We are really privileged to have such a towering personality among us today. We are sure sir, that your presence will motivate our students.

Dr Gurcharan Singh teaches Business Administration classes and handles subjects in the area of finance and strategic management. He travelled widely to different parts of the world for mutual exchange programmes and participating in conferences/seminars.

Dr. Dharam Singh Sandhu is the Registrar of Jagat Guru Nanak Dev Punjab State Open University, Patiala. He has an MSc, an MPhil and a PhD in Geography. He joined the Department of Higher Education as Assistant Professor on 28th January, 1988. He rendered his valuable services as the Principal of SCD Government College, Ludhiana from January 2013 to March 2021. He has played an instrumental role in the conduct of examinations like CA, CS, IAS. He is a memeber of Selection Boards, Chairman of numerous State and University bodies. He was honoured with State Award for his contribution to the field of Education by the then Chief Minister Capt. Amarinder Singh on 15th August, 2017. He successfully completed a UGC-sponsored Minor Project in 2002, and a UGC-sponsored Major Project in 2009. In addition to starting new courses, and organising national as well as international conferences as a Chief Coordinator, Dr. Sandhu's consistent and dedicated efforts as the Principal led to the accreditation of the college with 'A' grade. He has a significant number of international as well as national publications to his credit including 2 books, 2 translated books, several research papers, and a newsletter. He has attended twenty four international and national conferences. He has also contributed to the Encyclopedia of Punjabi University, Patiala. He chaired a session in an international conference GEOMED 2010 held in 2010. He holds the coveted posts of President, and Life member of various bodies and associations.




