Message

I feel nostalgic while writing this message on the occasion of Golden Jubilee Celebrations of my Alma Mater, Modi College which was founded in July 1967 by late R B Gujjar Mal Modi in the sacred memory of his father late R B Multani Mal Modi. I joined this great institution as the eleventh member of the team on October 4, 1967 only to mark time as I had imminent plans to go to the US for higher studies. Most of my colleagues were fresh from the universities and took teaching synonymous with leisure. But our Principal, Dr. H R Juneja, a renowned teacher of Chemistry was cast in an altogether different mould - a hard taskmaster who would goad us to bone-breaking work. "Duty is the stern daughter of God" was his constant refrain. Whether or not God procreated such a relentless daughter, I still do not know but undoubtedly Dr. Juneja was her sterner male version. For him if morning was the time for serious work, afternoon meant hard work and the evening demanded finishing the pending work. And then at the end of the day, he would reward us all with a lot more work which could not be completed even till late night.

We all resented and sulked. Every morning like "the whining school boy, with his satchel (full of notebooks of the students)", each one of us would "creep like snail unwillingly" to the college. Though still sleepy and haggard, we had to feign cheerfulness. A fresh and beaming Dr. Juneja would be at the college gate to assign us the work of the day that had just begun. A few of us who had no encumbrances wanted to run away and they did. For the rest, the circumstances so connived that they had to stay put- I belong to that species, the fittest who survive. Dr. Juneja was ahead of his times and he knew that the foundations of great institutions could be laid only with hard work. Nevertheless, he left an indelible mark on us. He taught us that only hard work is the true form of worship.

And then came Dr. H R Jindal--same initials (HRJ), belonging to the same discipline, Chemistry; same DAV-US fused training and of course the same workaholicism of Dr. H R Juneja. He brought with him a wind of change – he spiced work with affection and love. Very knowledgeable, an excellent teacher and a great administrator, Dr. Jindal had the longest tenure of thirteen years as the Principal. No doubt, everything in the college bears his stamp – he raised its status to dizzying heights of glory. The magnificent college building was completed in his time and dignitaries of the stature of President of India, Giani Zail Singh (the then Chief Minister of Punjab), President K R Narayanan (the then Vice Chancellor of JNU), Seth G M Modi, Seth K N Modi visited the college. While facing a host of difficulties smilingly, he subtly passed on the message that “perseverance is the hinge of all virtues”.

My immediate predecessor, Sh. S R Sahni had the longest stint of seven years after Principal H R Jindal. Before him, Sh. O P Dhiman, Sh. O P Vijh and Sh. R K Phul graced the Principal’s chair. Each one of them had endearing qualities. Whereas all the earlier Principals were father figures to me, Sh. S R Sahni was more of a brother than a Principal; friendly, affectionate and full of concern. I saw in him the sparks of Dr. Jindal- he never buckled under pressure.

For me it was a great experience to work with these doyens. If I learned the art of teaching from one, the other taught me how to be composed and sober even in the most turbulent of times. Barely did I know that I was silently being groomed to carry on their job one day. But I am a miniature of their tall statures. In fact, it is their training that has been helping me in serving this great institution for the last fifty years in various capacities.

It was Sh. S R Sahni who took the bold initiative of starting professional courses like BMIT, BCA, PGDCA etc. with the limited resources and space in the main college building. The state-of-the-art Seth H R Modi Centre of Computer Sciences and Business Management conceived during his tenure, came into being after he passed the baton to me. With the unstinted support of Chairman Seth S K Modi and the able guidance of late Gp. Capt. B P Puri, this gigantic project was completed in 2002. I still cherish the fond memories of that time when my colleagues: Prof. M L Malhotra, Prof. F C Badhwar and Prof. R R Syal toiled harder than me to see the project through in less than two years. And it was also that period when faculty members sat for late hours in the evening to finalize the NAAC report which ushered in the present spectacular progress.

Dr. Satish K Bhardwaj took over the reins of the college after a short stay of my successor, Dr. V K Sharma. During his seven years, the college made rapid strides in all fields, touched new heights in sports and a large number of postgraduate courses were launched. Due to his untiring efforts, UGC conferred on our college the status of "College with Potential for Excellence". Dr. Bhardwaj; unassuming, suave and hardworking, was instrumental in setting up labs in PG Block and building an imposing Commerce Block to meet the growing student influx. I have many pleasant memories of working with him as a member of Modi Educational Society.

After the superannuation of Dr. Satish K Bhardwaj in 2014, the responsibility of guiding the institution devolved on the shoulders of a young and dynamic educationist, Dr. Khushwinder kumar . His assuming the office marks an important stage in the history of the college. Though younger than the college itself, his wisdom and maturity coupled with sincerity of purpose is evident the way college is making all round progress: Reaccredited by NAAC with grade “A” – 3.26 CGPA and



College with Potential for Excellence CPE (II) by UGC. He has a good innings to play and is all set to take the college to further heights of glory. His is a story in the making.

Institutions never take a hiatus. The account of these historical reflections would, therefore, be incomplete without mentioning the dedicated services of my revered colleagues: late Dr. R N Trikha, late Dr. Shanti Khanna, late Sh. O P Sharma, Sh. Sushil Kumar and Sh. S B Mangla. They stood guard at uncertain and often difficult times to perform the duties of a Principal assigned to them by the Managing Committee.

It is also the most appropriate occasion to pay homage to our former Chairmen , late Justice G L Chopra and late Padma Shri Dr. Khushdeva Singh who guided the destiny of the college in its formative years . We are also indebted to our star-studded faculty and the staff who contributed their might to nurse the college from its infancy to the present towering status.

The labour of bygone arduous years is bearing fruit. We are proud of our innumerable students, who as administrators, doctors, engineers, army officers, industrialists, actors, singers are spreading their fragrance throughout the country and abroad. Name a profession and there is a Modiite excelling himself or herself. How did it all happen? Hard work with dedication.

This recapitulation of the history of our Alma Mater and my own evolution conveys the message – whatever appears murky and dismal to begin with, turns rosy and heartwarming with dedicated hard work. Toiling without expectation of a reward is true *karma*, i.e., action. Only *karma* is real. All else is a matter of belief.

“Live thou in action, so labour, strive, work.
Make thy actions thy worship to the Lord,
casting ego aside.”

We all feel proud of being Modiites. And an honest-to-goodness Modiite would be Moral, Obedient, Disciplined and Industrious - a MODI in the true sense. And for a Modiite :

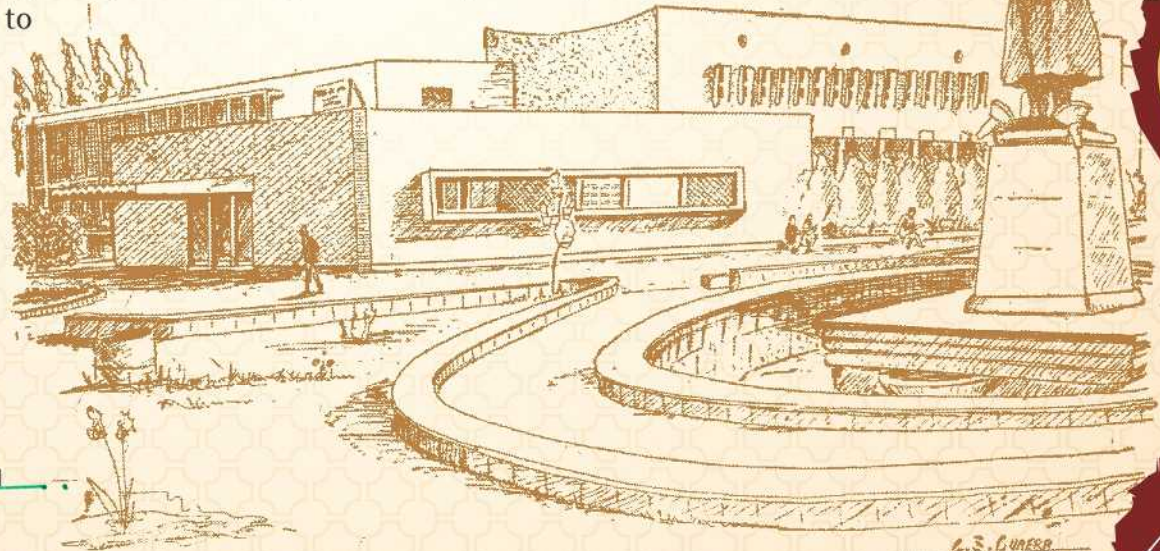

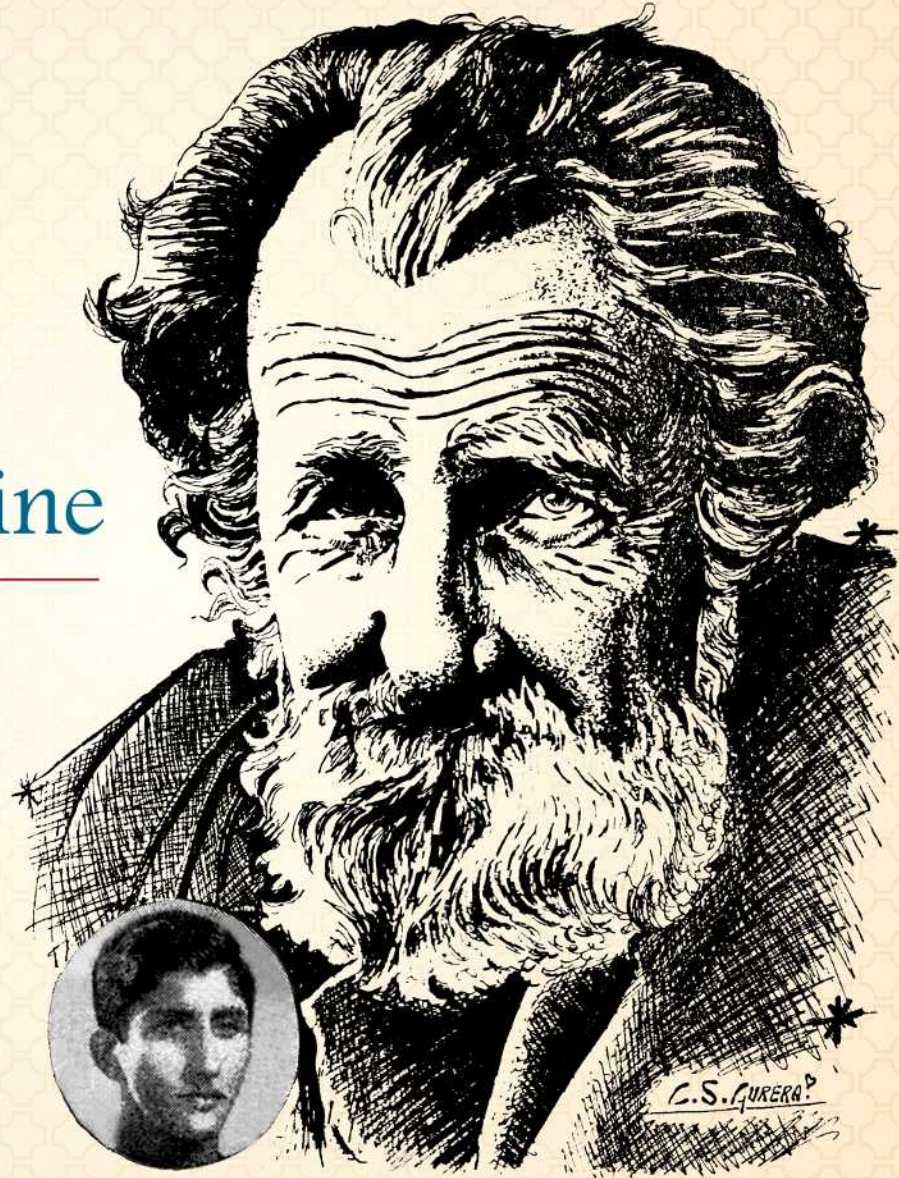

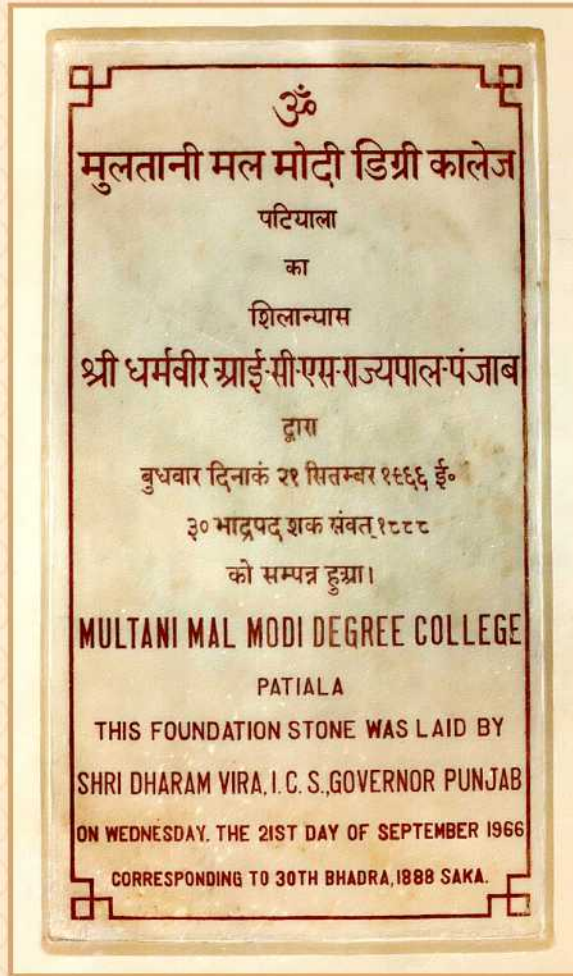

M M Modi College, Patiala has its genesis in the entrepreneurial history of India. Rai Bahadur Seth Gujjar Mal Modi, a legendary figure in the annals of Industrial Houses of India, founded this college in the fond memory of his illustrious father, Rai Bahadur Seth Multani Mal Modi on 21st October, 1966 and first session of the college started in July 1967. Seth Gujjar Mal Modi, being the eldest son of the family, joined his father's Patiala Flour Mill at a very young age and started working in the accounts section. His intense desire to learn and propensity to understand enabled him to read books of commerce, management and technology. To him, Patiala appeared too small a place to accommodate the industrial empire, he envisioned. He moved to Modi Nagar, a city named to recognize his contribution and established his industrial units there. The success of this genius enabled the Modi Family of Patiala to be counted among 20 Big Industrial Houses of India. He believed that the underlying principle for the development of the nation is to provide quality education to the people and that was the noble thought behind the establishment of Modi Education Society under the chairmanship of Justice G L Chopra. Padam Shri Dr Khushdeva Singh, Seth Chiranji Lal Ji and Sardar Amar Singh Kamboj were the founder members of this society. The choice of these members reflects the understanding, concern and commitment of the founders for the cause for which the society was set up. The philosophy of the management to impart 'Quality Education at Affordable Cost' has remained the guiding force for the Society since then. Through the liberal financial support to build state of the art infrastructure, enlightened managerial guidance and dedication and commitment of the principals and staff, this college is presently listed among the top colleges of this region. The people of this royal city and surrounding areas have patronized this college since its beginning.

Seth Sudarshan Kumar Modi, the present Chairman of Modi Education Society, follows the philanthropic spirit of his elders religiously. Its ability to grasp the undercurrents in the field of education and start new courses well in advance to match the needs of the society always keeps this college ahead of others.

Our college is acknowledged as the biggest contributor in the total marks required for winning All India MAKA Trophy by the Punjabi University, Patiala for years together.

Our college has a Central Instrument Lab equipped with latest and advanced instruments used in conducting experiments and chemical analysis by the research scholars of our college. This lab is also used by the students of other leading universities as well as by the industrial units of the region. We have four Computer labs, one Software Lab, one Multi-Media Lab and one Language Lab. We also have two labs each for Physics and Chemistry, one each for Botany, Zoology, Biotech, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Physical Chemistry and Food & Nutrition, which provide necessary infrastructure and enabling environment to enhance their competencies. Apart from this, the college has MOU (Memorandum Of Understanding) with IT companies to guide the students and provide technical training they need.

We have an impressively rich and fully computerized library where more than 62000 books on every subject are available for the students and the staff of this college. We subscribe to 70 Journals and magazines and 23 newspapers regularly for keeping the students and the staff well aware of the latest developments in their respective subjects. The facility of INFLIB NET is of immense use to the teaching staff.

An in-house designed fully computerized MIS (Management Information System), Udaan, is working very effectively in the college to keep record of all the students. It is also used for all administrative needs

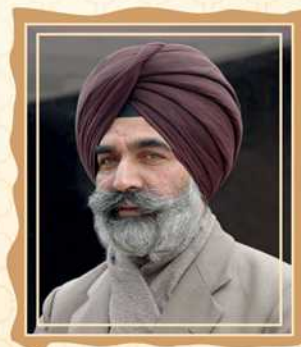
of the college. This system has enabled us to move towards cash-less operations.

The college is located right in the middle of the city which puts constraint on the space available for physical growth. But despite that constraint we have added one new block for the Commerce Faculty and expanded the parking facility for the students. In the next round of adding new class rooms, one new floor will be constructed before the start of the new session in 2018.

Principal Dr Khushvinder Kumar has infused a new spirit in the staff to participate more devotedly in research and publishing. He has planned to record lectures and make the learning material available to the students online and with God's grace; it will not be long before all students can use it to improve their academic achievements.

In recognition to the consistency in providing quality education over the last 50 years of its existence, this college has been reaccruited by NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) with Grade Excellence-II (CPE-II) in recognition of various initiatives undertaken to introduce new courses and promotion of research projects.

Since eons, the tradition has been that passing generation conditions the upcoming with their definition of success. An educational institution is a place where different generations interact continuously to learn and teach new ideas. This interaction can be more probing and purposeful when the environment is conducive. I am sure, with the blessings of our elders, enlightened direction of the management, supportive leadership of the principal and deep sense of devotion to the duty of the staff, this college will always strive to create that environment. I wish M M Modi College, Patiala continues to maintain its place of eminence in the service of imparting quality higher education and set new standards of success for its students.

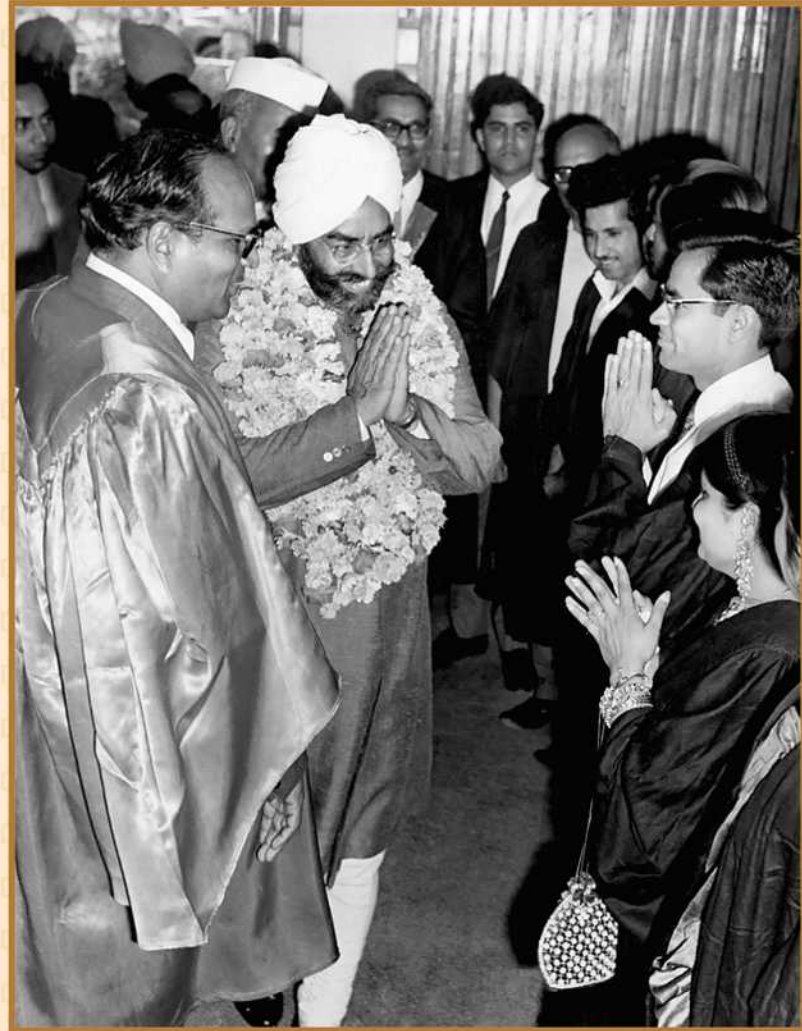

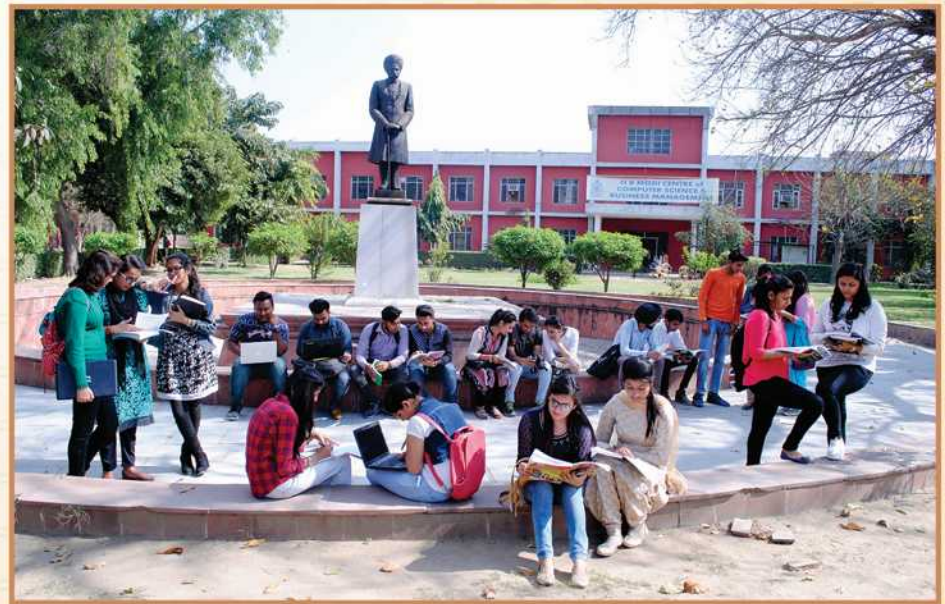

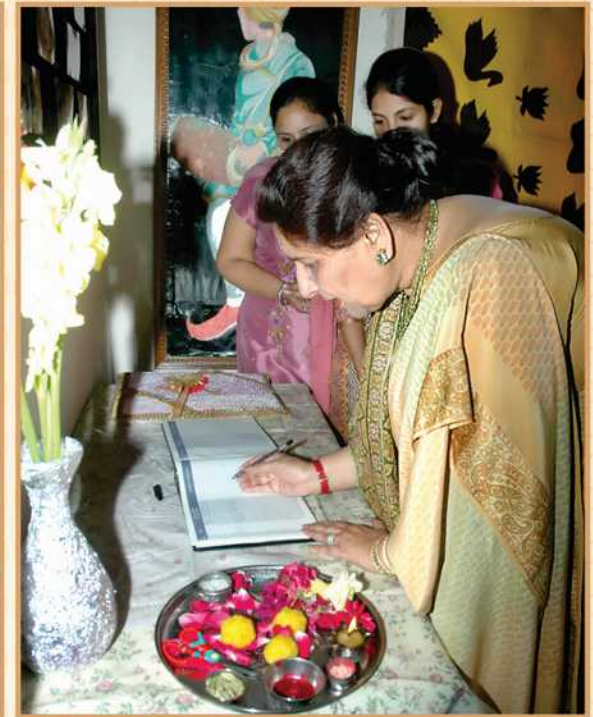
HERITAGE SOCIETY

Principal of the college Dr. Satish Bhandari stressed the need for organic research-based events.

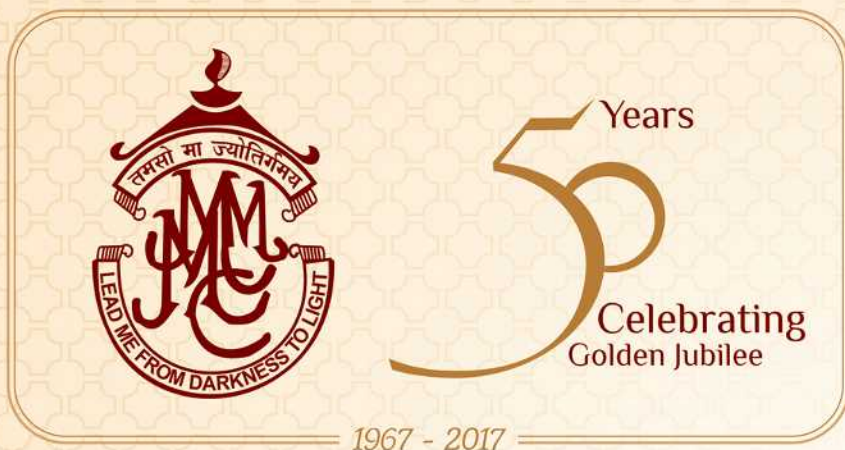

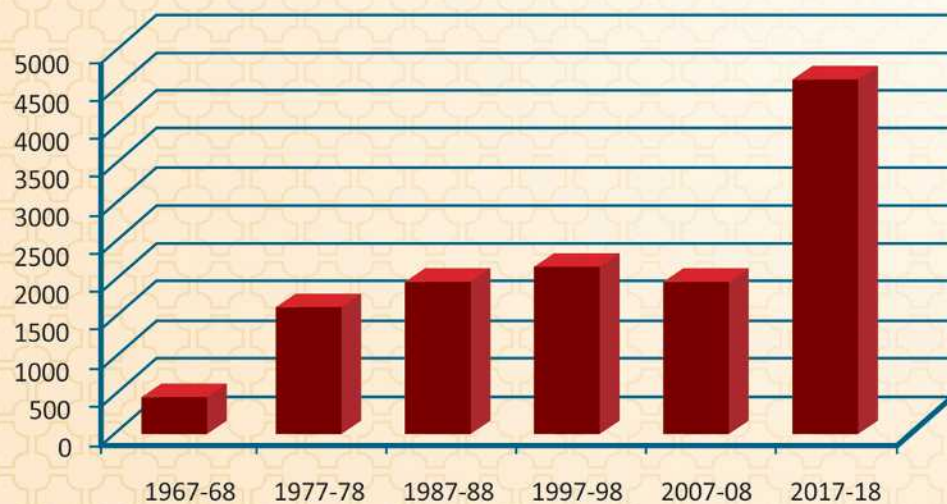
