
# DATA INTERPRETATION OF STUDENTS FEEDBACK ON TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS (2020-21)

The previous one and half year was the most challenging year for whole of the education scenario. The students were struggling to learn the things from various sources and particularly the online data sources took the lead in it. There was a new paradigm shift in the teaching learning process for the teachers. They have tried best to reach up to the students for dissemination of the knowledge. Apart from the teaching in the year 2020-21, again the co-curricular activities took place after a pandemic gap and teachers were successful enough to get the students engage in the different activities.

- The data shows that about 80% students took part in these activities. Also more than 70% of the students agreed that they got their different skills updated and were satisfied with the content and knowledge being provided by the teachers of Multani Mal Modi College in their classes.
- It is quite evident from the student's feedback that the use of ICT tools by the teachers is also moving upwards as more than 60% teachers now engaged their classes with the use of different ICT tools such as LED Projectors, Multimedia etc.
- The experimental and participative learning have been adopted by most of the teachers to give better learning experiences. Data shows that more than 72% teachers follow these type of approaches in the classes.
- The teachers put an extra effort to prepare and upload e-resources (lectures and presentations) on different platforms easily available to the students and the college administration developed a customized platform i.e. LMS, google classrooms, Zoom etc.
- The teachers are well prepared and they follow some of the excellent approaches to communicate and illustrate the concepts with examples and applications with their students. It is quite evident from the data that more than 95% teachers come to the classes with full preparation of the topics and concepts.
- In nut shell the quality of teaching learning process has improved a lot but perfection is not possible in this process. The students have an opinion that there is a strong procedure of follow-up the assignments and fair internal evaluation on the basis of their regular performance. About 80 percent students feel that the system is best in quality of teaching and learning process.
- More than 60% students praised the institute to take active interest in the promotion of the professional activities for the students which provide cognitive, social and emotional growth of the students.
- The complaint redressal and problem solving attitude of the teachers is being hailed by more than 75% of the students to make them comfortable in their journey of learning.
- The discussion of the future career opportunities, courses and challenges by the teachers with their students is being highly appreciated by the students as more than 75% of the students having the opinion that with this they were able to identify their strengths and weaknesses.

Overall by going through the feedback of the year 2020-21 it is very much clear that college is trying its level best to give a better and positive environment for academics, learning, growth and the all-round development of its students.




What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LED projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?


