His ability to perform well in each of the positions speaks volumes of his grit, intelligence, insight, and managerial skills. In addition to serving as Bursar, Warden, Dean, Syndic, and Senator at PU, he has rendered his invaluable services as a member of numerous committees of the university. He was selected to attend Leadership for Academicians Programme (LEAP) by the Government of India at the US in 2019, in addition to attending several international interactions, meetings, and conferences. His sagacity and vision has been acknowledged as the Guardian Professor of Government College, Muktsar. The membership of the Board of Studies of numerous universities underscores his efficiency at designing as well as amending curriculum.

His contribution to education has been suitably recognized by distinguished organisations as he is the recipient of Lifetime Achievement Award in the field of Management and Leadership, Best Administrator Award 2020, Best Business Academic award 2017, PCMA Research Award 2017 among other prestigious awards. 17 PhDs have been completed under his supervision. He has 5 books, 3 edited books, 51 articles, and a coffee book to his credit. His research articles have been published in several reputed journals like Vikalpa, Journal of Strategic Innovation and Sustainability, North American Business Press, Journal of Management Policy and Practice, etc. He successfully completed a research project titled “Corporate Brand Management” from Asian Productivity Organisation, Tokyo, Japan. His areas of interest include Contemporary Issues in Accounting and Finance, Corporate Social Responsibility, Corporate Governance, Strategic Management, and Spirituality & Ethics in Management.

Dr. Gurpreet Singh Lehal, a genie informatique, is an exemplary researcher, innovative developer, and a committed Scientist. He is serving as Professor at the Department of Computer Science since 2003, and Dean, College Development Council of Punjabi University, Patiala since 2021. In addition, he is the Director of Research Centre for Punjabi Language, Literature and Culture since 2004 and the Director of Centre for Artificial Intelligence and Data Science since 2018. He has rendered his services as Dean, Faculty of Computing Sciences, Punjabi University Patiala (2016-2018), and as Dean, Faculty of Physical Sciences, Punjabi University Patiala (2013-2015). As far as academics are concerned, he has an M.Sc. (Maths Hons) from Panjab University, an M.E. from Thapar Institute of Engineering and Technology, and a PhD (Computer Science) from Punjabi University, Patiala, to his credit. He began his professional journey as Systems Analyst/Research Engineer at Thapar Corporate Research & Development Centre, Patiala in 1988, and joined as a Lecturer at the department of Computer Science of Punjabi University, Patiala in 1995. His contribution to the fields of Natural Language Processing and Pattern Recognition is commendable. He is a valued member of numerous national as well as international committees like Content Review Committee for the Museum of Word Project, Government of India; ICANN (Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers) India Universal Acceptance Local Initiative; Panel on Character set for Indian Languages for Mobile phones, Bureau of Indian Standards; Committee for development of Script Grammar for Punjabi, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Government of India etc.

He has worked on 9 languages so far, developed 24 software as well as technologies, and has acquired copyright for 5 of his software. He has successfully completed three international research projects with a budget of around 60000 US dollars and 30000 AU dollars. In addition, he has had 15 national projects with a budget of around 62 crores. Regarding his research acumen, he has 65 Scopus indexed articles, and 2 international book/book chapters. His research work has been cited a massive 4200 times. His h-index is 31, and i10-index is 75. He has visited several countries for research/academic purposes. 21 PhDs, and 112 MTechs/MPhils have been completed under his guidance.


Convocation-2022
